#### MEMORANDUM OF SALE

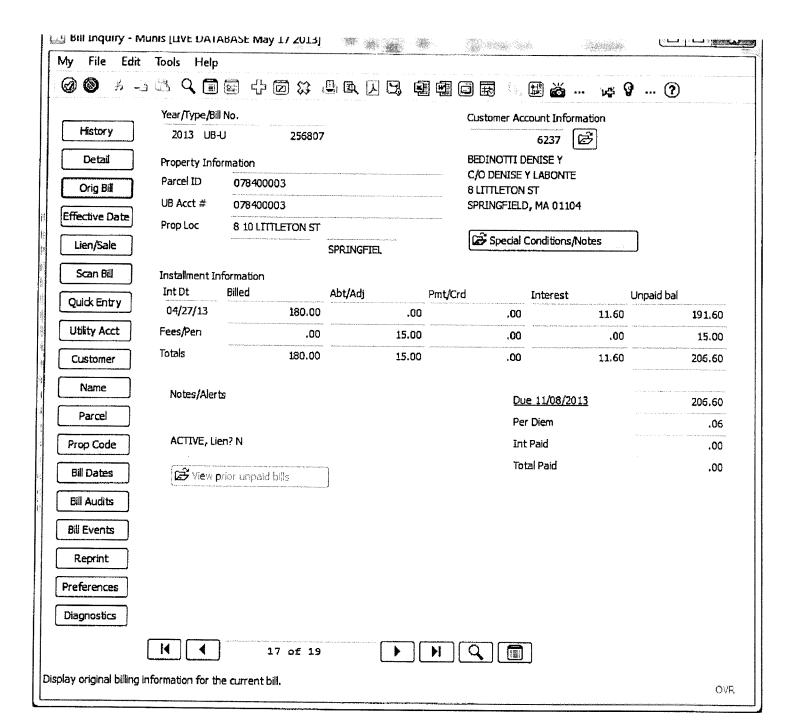
